Nepal, officially the Federal Democratic Republic of Nepal is a landlocked central Himalayan Country in South Asia. It has a population of 26.4 Million and is the 93rd largest country by area. Bordering China in the north & India in the south. east & west, it is the largest sovereign Himalayan State.

Nepal has a diverse geography, including fertile plains, subalpine forested hills and eight of the world's ten tallest mountains, including Mount Everest, the highest point on Earth. Kathmandu is the nation's capital and largest city. It is a multiethnic nation with Nepali as the official language.

The territory of Nepal has a recorded history since the Neolithic age. The name Nepal is first recorded in texts from the Vedic Age, the era which founded Hinduism, the predominant religion of the country. In the middle of The first millennium BCE, Gautama Buddha, the founder of Buddhism, was born in southern Nepal since the 8th century.

Nepal hosts the permanent secretariat of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC), of which it is a founding member. Nepal is also a member of the Non-Aligned Movement and the Bay of Bengal Initiative. Nepal has long standing bilateral treaties with the United Kingdom since 1923, India since 1950, and China since 1960. The Military of Nepal is the fifth largest in South Asia and is notable for its Gorkha History, particularly during the world wars, and has been a significant contributor to United Nations Peace keeping operations.

Modern Nepal is a federal secular parliamentary republic. It has seven states. Nepal is a developing nation, ranking 145th on the Human Development Index (HDI) in 2014.

Medicine in NEPAL

Nepal has been receiving much attention from international students who are looking for MBBS Admission in Nepal.

Their medical institutions are fully equipped with all the required amenities to teach and share information concerning the medical science.

Currently there are five categories of MBBS College in Nepal, few of those are affiliated with Tribhuvan University, Kathmandu University, B.P. Koirala Institute of Health Science, Patan Academy of Health Science & Karnali Academy of Health Science. The Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) is a four- and half-year integrated program followed by a compulsory internship training of one year. Generally, the MBBS program is divided into three parts.

The first two years of study consists of basic medical science. These years also includes an introduction to clinical science. Over the next two and half years, students learn the principles and skills of clinical medicine by rotating through various medical specialties. The final one year consists of internship.

The culture of Nepal is rich and unique. The cultural heritage of Nepal has evolved over the centuries. This multi-dimensional heritage encompasses the diversities of Nepal's ethnic, tribal, and social groups, and it manifests in music and dance; art and craft; folklore and folktales; languages and literature; philosophy and religion; festivals and celebration; foods and drinks.

Nepal Sompada Sangha (Nepal Heritage Society) has compiled an inventory of 1,262 significant architectural and archeological sites in Nepal outside Kathmandu Valley.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A. MBBS Course Durations: 4.5 Year+ 1 Year Internship

The candidate should have Passed 10+2 Science containing Physics, Chemistry and Biology with 50% aggregate in total marks or GPA 2.4 or Secured the percentage equivalent to above eligibility in regards to the certificate level programs (eg. A-level) with different grading system.

For Srilankan Students: Minimum "C" grades and "D" grades for International boards (EDEXCEL/Cambridge etc.), at the A" level or equivalent examination.

Age should be at least 17 years by the last date of submission of application are eligible to apply in the MBBS or BDS course.

There are 02 ways of admission in Nepal. One through Entrance Education conducted by Medical Education Commission & Another Direct admission through NEET score of current year.

A.1 Through Entrance Examination Conducted By Medical Education Commission.

The Candidates who wish to study MBBS in Nepal at B.P. Koirala Institute of Health Science, Dharan; Institute of Medical Science (IOM), Kathmandu; Patan academy of health science, Kathmandu; Karnali Academy of Health Science, Karnali; Nepalese Army Institute of Health Science, Kathmandu & Kathmandu University School of Medical Science, Kathmandu need to appear this entrance examination.

All candidates should score at least 50% in the entrance examination to qualify for being in the merit list.

The allocation of seat & college will be done through "MATCHING" Mechanics as per the Merit and priority order selected by the candidate by Medical Education Commission (MEC)

A.2 Directly through NEET Score for Indian Students

Students who are looking for direct admission in any of the Private medical can get admission based on NEET Qualifying score of India.

Only Current Academic year NEET score will be considered for admission.

The General Category minimum NEET score will only be considered for admission.

A. Application form for the admission into Medical Colleges in Nepal is available in the month of September / October which can be collected from our Authorized Centers in India & Abroad.

Dully filled application form along with the following documents

- Passport or Aadhar Card Recent Passport size picture
- 10th, 12th Marksheet – attested with Notary lawyer /authorizelsignatory like Principal
- Application Fee charge of INR 5000/- payable to Medical Education Commission, Nepal.
- NEET Score card if applying for direct admission based on NEET score.

Note 1. : Exam are conducted only at Centers of Nepal so students need to travel to Nepal to appear for examination conducted by MEC.

Note 2. : If Applicants applying through Medical Entrance Examination are More compared to Direct NEET Admission then the Priority will be given to such candidates who has qualified Entrance Examination conducted by MEC.

Note 3. All candidates should score at least 50% in the entrance examination to qualify for being in the merit list. 50% -50 percentile

About Medical Education Commission (MEC)

As per provision of the National Medical Education Act 2075 B.S, in the context of the essence and spirit of the reports of the commission, committee and task force formed to improve medical education at different times; Medical Education Commission has been established to:

- Increase the investment of the state in the field of medical education,
- Develop medical education in line with the national needs of Nepal,
- Regulate medical education in integrated and efficient way,
- Organize the work related to the establishment and operation of medical institutions,
- Maintain quality, professionalism, institutional accountability, geographical balance and social justice in medical education,
- Ensure equal access of all students including the deprived.

Note 1 : Foreign students who want to study in Government Medical Colleges like BP Koirala, Patan Academy of Health Science, Institute of Medicine, Nepalese Army, Karnali Academy of Health Science need to appear entrance examination conducted by MEC. It is compulsory for students to fill the application form and deposit the prescribed application form charge to appear the CEE (Common Entrance Examination) conducted by MEC. However, if any seats are vacant then it will be given through merit of NEET score.

Note 2 : One student can fill only one form either through exam or NEET score.

PROGRAMS & ACADEMICS

Bachelor Of Medicine And Bachelor Of Surgery (MBBS Program)

Medical colleges in Nepal provide a four & a half years MBBS degree program in all the preclinical subjects and selected clinical subjects. The four and a half years MBBS course is divided into 9 semesters of 6 months each. Upon successful completion of the course, students will undergo a 1-year compulsory residential rotating internship. The medium of instruction is English.

MBBS Curriculum-Preclinical (Semesters I-IV) The first and second years of instruction cover integrated Preclinical Sciences, Community Medicine, Introduction to clinical Medicine and Medical Informatics. Preclinical Science includes Anatomy, Microbiology, Pathology, & Pharmacology & Physiology. These subjects are taught in an integrated manner and are incorporated into Community Medicine and introduction to clinical Medicine. Students gain clinical knowledge and problem-solving skills. Medical informatics is integrated to provide computer expertise relevant to medical education.

At the end of the first year and second year there are university examinations on each of the above subjects.

A student must complete all subjects of the practical science - first year MBBS within three from the date of admission & second year within four from the date of admission.

A student is required to pass all the preclinical subjects before he/she is allowed to be promoted to the clinical sciences (Semester V)

Clinical Sciences [Semester V-IX] Clinical sciences include the subjects of forensic medicine, Community Medicine, Ophthalmology {ENT} Medicine & Allied Subjects, Psychiatry, Dermatology, Radiology, Emergency Medicine & More], Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics and other allied medical and surgical specialties & sub-specialties.

The third year MBBS university examinations in Forensic Medicine, Community Medicine Ophthalmology are held at the end of the seventh semester. A student cannot be admitted to the ninth semester until he/she has passed all four subjects. At the end of nine semesters are the final MBBS university examinations in Medicine and Allied Subjects, Surgery, Obstetrics, Gynecology and Pediatrics.

Evaluation

A system of continuous evaluation is followed through fortnightly tests semester exams end-posting evaluation, seminars & problem-based learning sessions.

The continuous evaluation system has helped to achieve excellent results in the university examinations.

Teaching Methodology: The teaching program in preclinical consists of

- Didactic
- Classroom lectures
- Practical's
- PBLs/Seminar Community/Hospital visits

Fortnightly, academic time tables are prepared, giving details of the teaching program with topics to be covered. These are put up well in advance to support the integrated approach, seminars and PBLs are conducted every fortnight on important diseases/syndromes.

This gives the preclinical students a better clinical orientation of the systems being taught. Concurrent evaluation is done by fortnightly test, viva - voce, seminars and PBLs Semester examinations are held at the end of each 5 months. The teaching program in Clinical Sciences consists of :

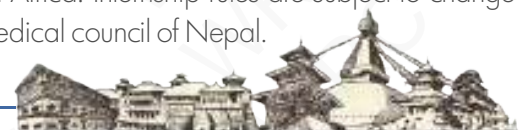
- Clinical/ Practical training in hospitals, wards /Community visits/Field training camp
- Symposia/Seminar
- Clinical meeting/Faculty talks/Guest Lectures

The above teaching sessions take an average of forty- two hours/week, out of which there are 12 didactic lectures per week.

The stress is mainly on Clinical Practical training. The Students are Periodically Assessed by conducting end posting clinical exams (Clinical and Viva), mid-Semester Exams and end-semester exams.

Internship

One Year of rotating internship is compulsory. The Kathmandu University and Nepal Medical Council have approved six different schemes for internship for student of different countries, as per the requirements of their medical council. Students do their internships in Nepal, India, Sri-Lanka, Australia, USA, UK and South Africa. Internship rules are subject to change as per the rules of medical council of Nepal.

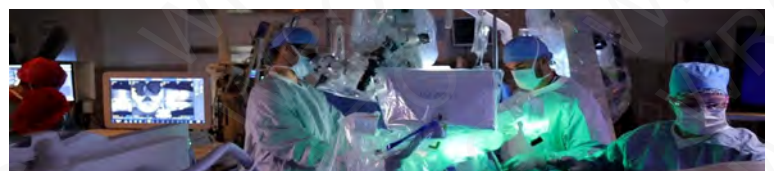

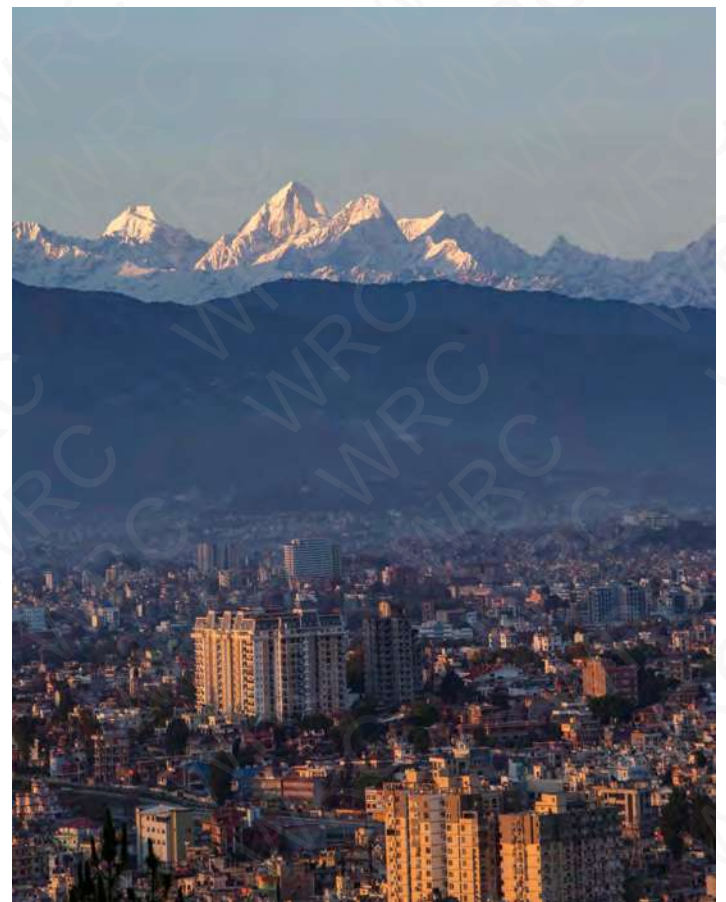

Information for Indian Students Desirous of Pursuing Medical Studies in Nepal

Over the years, there has been an increase in the number of Indian students coming Nepal to pursue medical education. Earlier, all students interested in taking a medical qualification from Nepal were required to get an eligibility certificate from the government before leaving for their studies. However, since 2019, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has made it mandatory for the students to clear the NEET-UG (National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test-Under Graduate) exam, which is the entry examination for undergraduate medical education in India, as a prerequisite to pursue medical education abroad.

Do's & Don'ts for Prospective Indian students before taking admissions in Medical Colleges of Nepal

Do's

1. Students must ensure that they strictly fulfil the eligibility criteria for their admissions as per the regulations of Nepal as well as of India, including passing of NEET-UG.
2. All necessary documents are required to be verified thoroughly as per the rules and regulations of Medical Education Commission, Nepal.
3. Students should approach the college / authorised Representative directly to check if it is a bonafide institution and must gather authentic information about the eligibility criteria, procedures of admission, availability of faculties, curriculum, facilities for practical, etc. Students should not merely depend on the website of the College. Prior to getting admission, the student should also explore the social media and extract various information/details including reputation/grading of the colleges/Universities and its examination system.
4. While seeking admissions, students should check the results of previous years and the proportionate pass percentages of Indian students from a particular College.
5. Before taking final decision for admission, the student must speak with existing Indian students of the Colleges and ascertain problems, if any. The student should gather all details very carefully pertaining to the procedure for examinations, re-examinations, revaluation of answer -sheets and charges involved thereof, number of permitted attempts to clear re-examinations, NFTE (Not Fit for Technical Education) criteria, etc.
6. The fee component and its mode of payment should be understood clearly. If possible, an authentic signed copy of fee payment schedule (including year wise fee structure, instalments and date of payment against each instalment) should be taken from the College/University in Nepal. Some colleges charge heavy penalty (almost 100%) on the pending dues, which may lead to heavy financial burden on the student. All these should be clarified before seeking admission.
7. Detailed enquiry should be made about facilities being provided by the college including hostel, food, transportation, medical, etc., and expenses towards these. The student must ask for hidden charges levied by the College, if any.

Don'ts

1. The student should be beware of any Authorised Agent or Consultancy services either for seeking admission in MBBS in Nepal or asking for any discount for fee, etc. since tuition fee remains same for all the students which is prescribed by the College.
2. The student should refrain from engaging in unlawful/political activities after getting admission in the college.
3. All the Payment should be made directly to the University or college mentioned in the admission letter.

Quick Facts:

- There is Direct Admission for Students who are seeking admission in any Private Medical College provided student should be NEET Qualified and score of that that particular year will be only considered. Previous year NEET score will not be considered for direct admission.
- It is compulsory to fill MEC Application form in due time paying INR 5000 for being eligible to get admission in Nepal
- Student seeking admission in Nepal should fill one MEC form with one option only through CEE exam or through NEET score
- The Internship of 1 year will be in Nepal itself and it is valid in India as per Govt of India.
- The Entire Package of Every college will vary from other.
